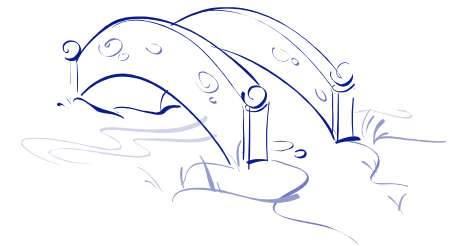
Providing possibilities is the cornerstone of our mission.

- ◆ Do more for themselves so that they can do more for others

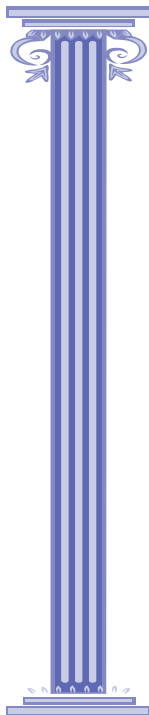
